Today's edition of the Tribune-Herald is dedicated to Keiki Day.

What's Keiki Day?

The annual charity event, now in its fourth year on Hawaii Island, benefits family service agency Parents and Children Together. PACT assists more than 18,000 parents, children and families each year, serving around 400 Big Island keiki in its Head Start and Early Head Start programs.

Founded on Oahu in 1968, the private nonprofit organization now has 18 programs statewide, focusing on early childhood education, domestic violence prevention and treatment, child abuse prevention and treatment, mental

health support and economic and community development.

To help raise money for PACT, more than 1,500 community volunteers around the state are hitting the street to sell Keiki Day editions of West Hawaii Today, the Tribune-Herald, the Honolulu Star-Advertiser and the Garden Island newspaper on Kauai.

Each special edition costs \$1. All proceeds benefit PACT — celebrating its 50th year — and its programs.

PACT receives funding from state and federal resources as well as private grants and donations, but Keiki Day is the organization's largest fundraising opportunity of the year. Funds from today's

event will help PACT continue to provide its many services and fill the gaps created by cuts to other social service programs.

Copies of the Keiki Day edition also go to all public and private schools on the Big Island, thanks to the generosity of business and individual sponsors. Many teachers will use the newspapers in their lesson plan.

Today's edition features artwork, stories and poetry made by Hawaii Island students as part of PACT's Keiki Day Creativity Contest. Winners were selected by a panel of judges, and are featured in this section beginning on Page C4.

This year's theme is "Together."

Head Start enables keiki to hit kindergarten running

PAHOA — When 5-year-old Veronica Silva arrives to her Head Start classroom each morning, she partakes in a six-hour day filled with fun and learning.

In one area of the classroom there's a "block center" where Veronica and her classmates learn mathematical concepts such as size, weight and numbers.

In another corner there's a "dramatic play center" where they might role-play being a doctor or firefighter, or pretend to make a burger or pizza.

Other activities on the schedule might include music, outdoor play and practicing good hygiene habits such as toothbrushing.

"(Veronica's) favorite part (of Head Start) is story time," mom Karen Silva said recently during an interview at Head Start's Hawaiian Beaches site where Veronica attends. "She's always telling me about the books she's reading here and she wants me to get them at home."

Veronica is one of nearly 400 Hawaii Island keiki enrolled in Head Start and Early Head Start, two early child education programs offered locally by the non-profit organization Parents and Children Together.

Head Start serves children ages 3-5. Early Head Start is for infants and toddlers through age 3, as well as prenatal parents.

There are 18 sites islandwide, mainly in East Hawaii. Both programs primarily serve children from low-income families and those with special needs.

"The whole goal is really to prepare children for future learning," said Keala Rowland, Big Island assistant program director for the programs. "We find that a lot of the children

that do come, after they go into kindergarten, they are more ready to follow routines, they know basic rules and expectations and it's really beneficial."

"We make sure that when they enter kindergarten they are in step with their peers."

All Early Head Start services offered on Hawaii Island are home-based, but that is hoped to change later this year: The Hawaiian Beaches site is working to open the first center-based Early Head Start program on Hawaii Island by this fall, according to Area Manager Malin Moy.

"It's exciting, we're almost there," Moy said of the Early Head Start expansion. "It's going to be really nice. We have a lot of parents here who have children 3 and under. So there are several who will have children (in two classrooms)."

"School is fun that's what we want to do," Moy continued. "It's hands-on, they are still allowed to be kids, but there is a lot of learning going on in that day."

Silva said Veronica has gained confidence through attending Head Start and also has gained experience

socializing and interacting with other children.

Silva said she especially has enjoyed working with Head Start "family advocates" who work one-on-one directly with parents. Silva said her family advocate has shown her new methods of handling common child meltdowns and also provided her with additional support: Many of her relatives live in South Africa, where she is from originally.

"When you're at home with your child and you get flustered and you don't know how to deal with certain situations,

it really helps to have a parent advocate who might say 'Why don't you try this or that?'" Silva said. "Especially in an area where you don't have your entire family here, your school becomes like your second family."

"It's just a great start for the children," Silva continued. "It provides a great foundation for the kids before they go to a big school. It's a great head start for them and it encourages them to do well in the next phase of their life."
